

This report was prepared on 12-21-03 by Park Patrol Officer Michael Lange, Badge 2833, in reference to Park Patrol Control Number 03-22050, a citation issued at the Big Rivers Trail.

On 12-20-03, at 2325 hours, I noticed an unoccupied Buick Century at the Big Rivers Trail Scenic Overlook parking lot. I activated my vehicle's amber safety lights and used the vehicle's public address system to state, "This is the Dakota County Park Patrol, the park is now closed, please come to the vehicle." No one responded to my request. I then visually looked inside the vehicle through the windows and noticed directions to a St Paul address on the front passenger seat. I could not see any signs that the vehicle had mechanical problems.

I identified the vehicle's registered owner by running the Minnesota Plate KJL582 through dispatch. The vehicle's registered owner came back as Michael Alan Hatch, DOB 11-12-1948, of 320 E 135th St, Burnsville, MN, 55337. I issued the vehicle field citation number 8174 to the windshield in accordance with Dakota County Park Ordinance #107, Chapter 7, Section B, Article 2, for parking a vehicle after hours without a permit. I secured the field citation under the driver's side windshield wiper.

There are park hour signs at this park, one is at the entrance of the park on the right hand side and the other is at the entrance of the trail. These signs state, "Open Sunrise to Sunset." In addition to the two signs, there are several lists of rules located in the informational kiosk at the entrance of the trail that reference park hours. Two of these lists state, "Park Hours: Sunrise to Sunset." There is also a 2003 sunrise and sunset table located in that kiosk. The sunset time listed for 12-20-03 is 1630 hours.

I cleared the scene at 2339 hours.
